

## Bale Clamps

Bale Clamp - Particularly useful for lifting or stacking lots of goods, bale clamps can be used as a hydraulic lift truck or forklift attachment in order to carry bales without using a pallet. Bar arm clamps are actually additional attachments that could be attached to allow the individual operating it to be able to lift cylindrical objects like rolls of carpet or paper.

There is a variety of forklift attachments available in order to make the machinery much more efficient. A snowplow attachment can be mounted to the front of the forklift. A scoop bucket can be useful whenever the task requires moving sand, gravel, soil or snow. A double block handler permits the person operating the forklift to pick up 2 loads and then pile them side-by-side. Many of those attachments are really great for light to medium tasks.

Another forklift attachment is the package lift clamp, that can lift and transfer very heavy pallets. Furthermore, pallet crane forks may be used so as to lift and move pallets with an overhead crane. A drum clamp attachment is useful for moving very heavy drums from place to place without having to use a pallet. Lift truck mounted hoppers enable materials to be moved and dumped without having to handle it by hand. These hoppers when the bumper is released are self dumping.

There are even attachments available which could transform the lift truck into a commercial mop or broom. Those accessories are ideal for cleaning boat docks, warehouse floors and parking areas. Lift truck mounted platforms come equipped with twin entry doors and can be attached to be able to move personnel from one area to another. The mounted platform attachment is great for reaching places which are hard to access, particularly when you've got products or things stored in out of the way places or way up high.

Attachments could be a very helpful piece of equipment when installed onto a forklift, transforming a usual forklift into a mobile hoist unit. It is most helpful when maneuvering unbalanced or awkward loads. This attachment could either be mounted on the carriage itself, telescopic, or be attached or even lift truck mounted.

Another sensible forklift attachment investment will be the carton clamp. Some think this piece could be the most useful attachment you possibly can buy. It allows the operator to be able to handle goods that does not have a pallet. Home equipment and furniture are good examples of things that come without a pallet, however that are huge and very heavy to require a lift truck for transportation.
