

Carriages

Carriage for Forklift - Rated by the blade carriage hoisting capacity, there are four sizings of hook type tine carriages. The hook type tine carriages have been standardized.

The carriage bar spacing for Class 1 is more or less 13 inches and the Class 1 carriage is rated to carry loads up to 2000lbs. The Class 2 carriage is rated to hold cargo as much as 5,500lbs with carriage bar spacing of 16 inches. Class III carriages are rated for cargo up to 10,000 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this particular class is 20 inches. Class IV carriages are rated for cargo as much as 15,500 lbs. The carriage bar spacing for this capacity is twenty five inches.

Pin mounted tines vary by the amount of offset between the fork and the tine eye. Various manufacturers will vary the carriages for pin type forks. Carriage capacity will be determined by the carriage pin size and by the fork size.
